

**Orange Tapioca Dessert**

- 2 boxes of cook and serve tapioca pudding
- 1 box (3 oz.) orange gelatin
- 2 large cans of mandarin oranges, drained
- 3 1/2 cups water
- 1 container (8 oz.) Cool Whip

Mix tapioca pudding mixes, gelatin mix, and water together. Bring to a boil. Cook for one minute. Cool about 3-4 hours. Add mandarin oranges, then add Cool Whip. Store in refrigerator.
