Pauline Heck's Ham Balls

- 1 1/2 pounds ground ham
 - 1 pound ground pork
 - 2 eggs
 - 1 cup cracker crumbs
 - 1/2 cup milk
- Mix ground ham, pork, eggs, cracker crumbs and milk together. Roll into balls and bake at 350° for 50 minutes.

Sauce:

- 1 cup brown sugar
 - 1 teaspoon ground mustard
 - 1/3 cup vinegar
 - 1/4 cup water
- Heat sauce ingredients together in a pan. Place meatballs in a slow cooker and pour sauce over the top. Keep hot using warm or low settings of slow cooker.
