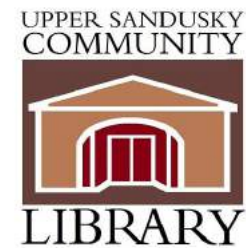

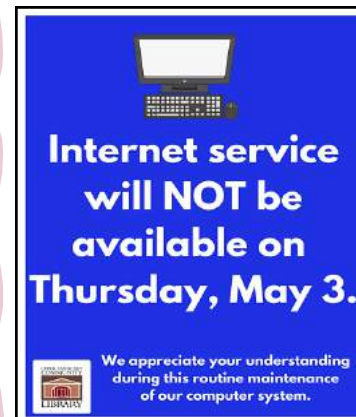

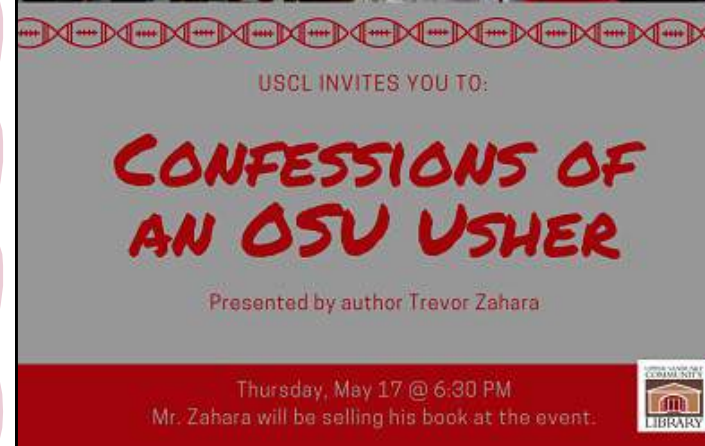

Charlene Beeler's Cocktail Sausage Bites

- 1 pound of cocktail sausages
- 1/2 cup margarine or butter, melted
- 2/3 cup chopped pecans
- 2/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 tubes of crescent rolls

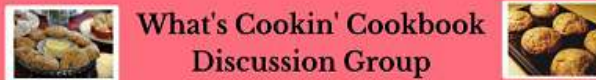
Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a small bowl, mix together the melted margarine or butter, pecans, and brown sugar. Pour this mixture into a 9x13 baking pan. Open the tubes of crescent rolls and cut each triangle lengthwise into thirds. Roll one sausage in each piece of roll, then place on top of pecan mixture in pan. Bake, uncovered, for 30 minutes or until browned.

Diana Dailey's Strawberry Cheesecake Salad

- 8 oz. container Cool Whip
- 1 box (3.5 oz.) cheesecake pudding mix, dry*
- 3 containers (6 oz. each) strawberry yogurt
- 1 pound sliced strawberries
- 3 sliced bananas
- 3 cups mini marshmallows

Combine the Cool Whip, dry pudding mix, and yogurt in a bowl. Refrigerate for one hour. Mix the strawberries, bananas, and marshmallows into the yogurt mixture just before serving.

*try coconut cream pudding mix or other similar flavors that you like. Yummy!
