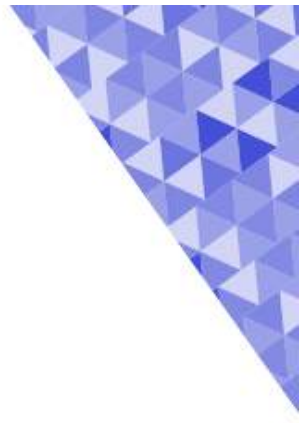




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Using wordless picture books can help improve children's language and spark their imagination.



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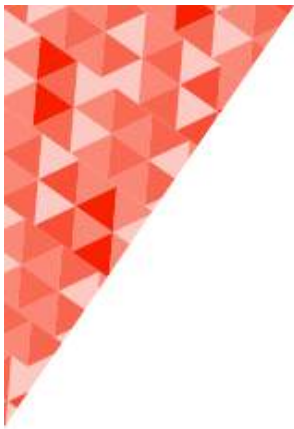
