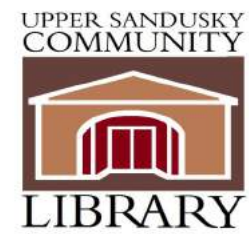

Joyce Walton's Butternut Squash Casserole

4 cups cooked, mashed butternut squash

1½ cups brown sugar

2 eggs, beaten

1½ teaspoons vanilla

½ cup milk

½ cup butter, melted

Topping:

½ packed brown sugar

1/3 cup flour

1/3 cup butter, melted

1 cup chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350° and grease a 9x13 baking dish. Combine butternut squash, brown sugar, beaten eggs, vanilla, milk, and melted butter. Pour mixture into the baking dish. Combine topping ingredients and sprinkle over the top. Dust with cinnamon. Bake for 35-40 minutes.
