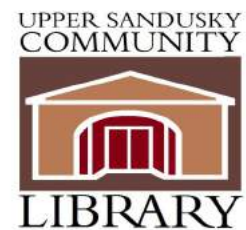

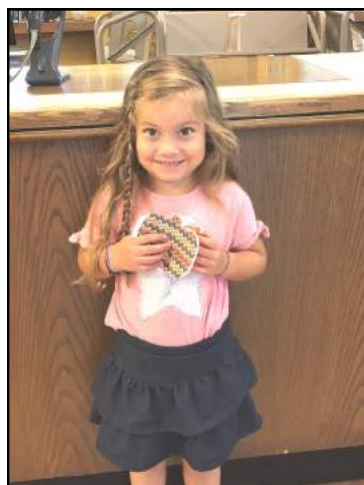

Brian Hemminger's Spaghetti Squash Lasagna

- 1 spaghetti squash
- 1 Tablespoon Olive oil
- 1 pound Italian sausage
- 24 oz. marinara sauce
- 8 oz. cream cheese
- ½ cup sour cream
- 1 Tablespoon chopped parsley
- 2 cups shredded mozzarella

Preheat oven to 400° and spray a rimmed baking sheet with non-stick spray.
Cut the spaghetti squash in half lengthwise and scoop out seeds. Drizzle inside of squash with olive oil. Place squash flesh side down and bake for one hour. Remove from oven and use fork to scrape long strands. Brown the sausage in a large sauce pan. Add marinara and cook for 5 minutes. Combine the

cream cheese, sour cream, and parsley and mix well. In a 9x13 pan layer half of the spaghetti squash strands, then half of the meat sauce. Layer the cream cheese mixture over the meat sauce, then add the rest of the spaghetti squash and top with the rest of the meat sauce. Cover with 2 cups of mozzarella. Bake for 20 minutes at 350° until the cheese melts and starts to brown.
