




Mary Kay Andrews' Broccoli Salad

2 (12 oz.) bags broccoli florets 34 cup dried sweetened cranberries ½ cup pecans, toasted

½ cup shelled, roasted and salted sunflower seeds

½ cup diced red onion

2 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled

1 cup mayonnaise

3 Tbsp. sugar

Grated zest and juice of 1 lemon

1 Tbsp. rice vinegar

1 ½ tsp. sea salt

Freshly ground pepper

Bring a large pot of salted water to boil. Add the broccoli and cook for 30 seconds. Drain and plunge into an ice water bath to stop cooking. Drain again, and pat dry with paper towels. Combine the broccoli, cranberries, pecans, onion sunflower seeds, and bacon in a large serving bowl. Whisk together the mayonnaise, sugar, lemon zest and juice, vinegar, poppy seeds and salt and pepper to taste in a small bowl. Pour the dressing over the broccoli mixture and toss to coat well. Cover and refrigerate until ready to serve.
